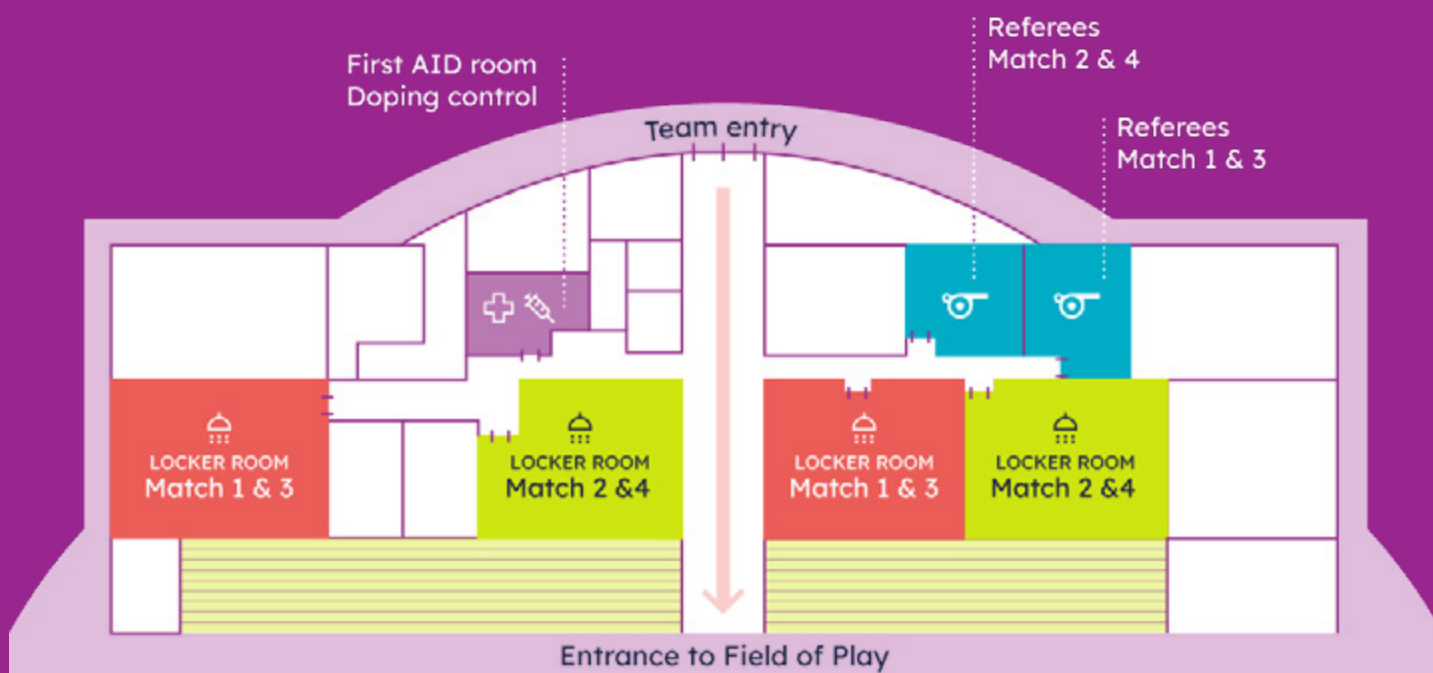

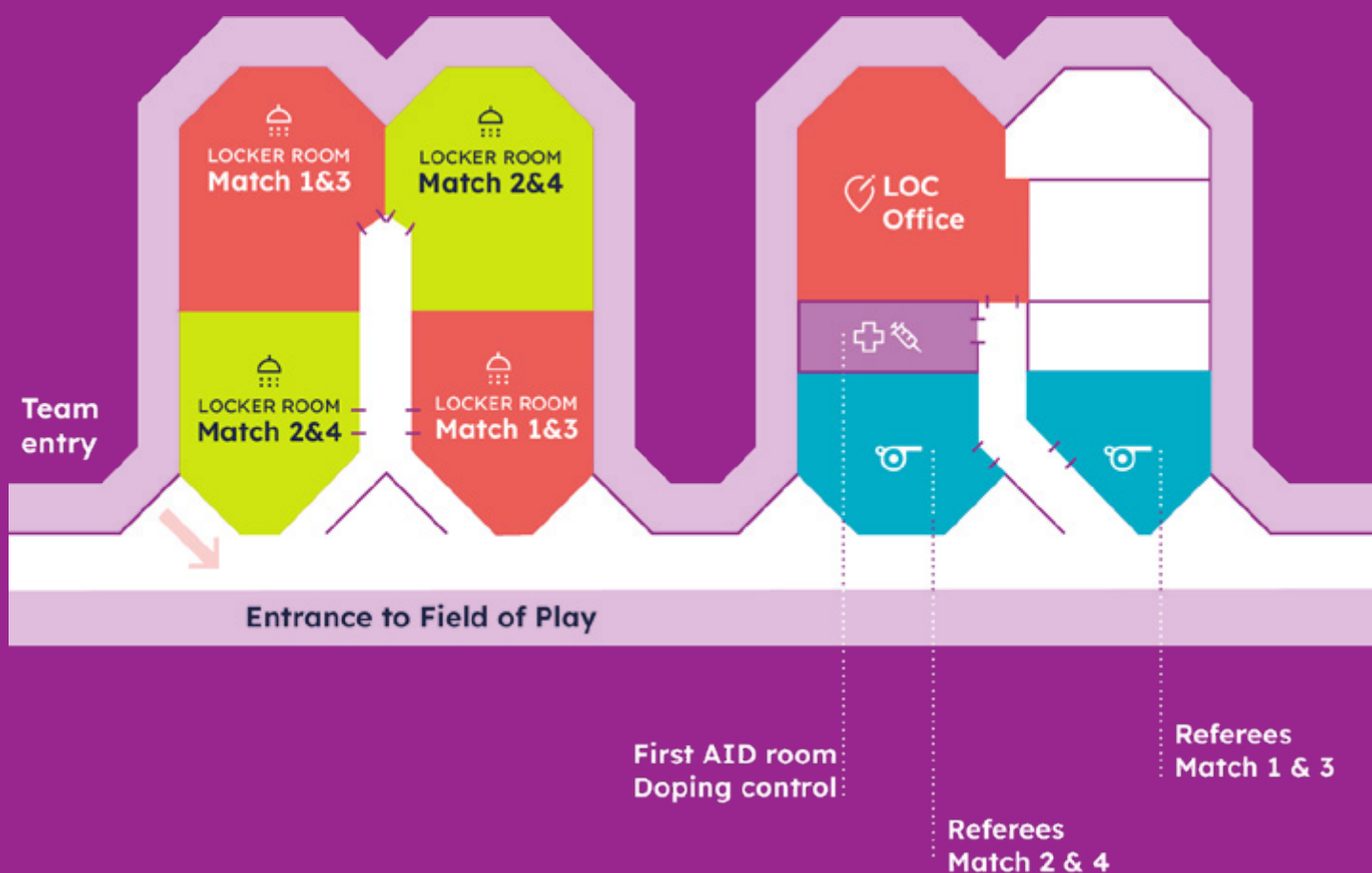

# TECHNICAL INFORMATION

## CAPTAIN'S MEETING

5 May 2026 | 20:00 | LIGNANO SABBIADORO

## OPENING CEREMONY

Opening ceremony will take place before the CAN v ITA game.

Teams attendance is not obligatory.

Canada and Italy will be asked to end their warm-up 20 min before the match start time.

## MEDIA INFORMATION

IFF and LOC rely on the teams to follow all instructions as requested with the media and to be open and helpful to media representatives. When posting about the event please use: #floorball #TakeTheFloor #u19wfc2026

### MIXED ZONE

After the match all the players and coaches will exit the arena through the Mixed Zone. TV journalists have the right to interview first. NO cool-down on the court after the match.

## IFF MOBILE APP

The IFF Media Platform / App is a great communication tool for the IFF, teams, floorball fans, member associations and all those involved in the sport, helping you follow each international game even more.

It is available for iOS and Android, as well as a web-browser version.

## LIVESTREAMS

All livestreams will be behind a paywall. A single game will cost 7.99e for the group and play-off matches and 9.99e for the semi-finals and medal game. A finals pass (semis and medal matches) is 12.99e and a full event pass (all games) is 19.99e. All highlights will be for free.

## TEAM MEDIA ATTACHÉS

Your designated team media attachés have access to the team areas anytime within 90 minutes prior to your match start and up to 60mins after your match ends

The access is strictly limited to their own team's locker room

It is up to each team to decide with their media attaché as to when you will let them (within the allowed time) access the locker room and what activities they are allowed to carry out while they are there (eg. interviews, video filming etc)

### DRESSING ROOM ACCESS FOR TV

Even if they are accredited media, permission for any TV company to access your locker room must be requested from & approved by the IFF

The Host Broadcaster may request access to a team's dressing room to show pre-match preparations. This will be coordinated with each team by the IFF & LOC media staff

## FILMING OF THE MATCHES

Filming of any part of the matches by accredited team members is strictly forbidden. Only the approved media may film matches. Any teams/team members found to be recording matches will be breaking IFF rules, and will risk having their accreditation taken away as well as having monetary fines imposed upon them and their Association

### GAME RECORDINGS

All match videos, highlights, and coach camera footage will be available to teams via dropbox link (provided to teams in 3rd Team information letter).

Match recordings and coach camera footage should be available approx. 1hr after each game, highlights approx. 2-3hrs.

# ANTI-DOPING & MEDICAL INFORMATIONS

## DOPING CONTROL

### THERAPEUTIC USE EXEMPTION (TUE)

Players taking prohibited medication should already have applied for a TUE.

Late TUEs can be submitted at anytime, but must be accompanied by a sanction fee of 300 CHF.

Approval of TUEs is not immediate – they must be reviewed by the IFF Medical Committee so can take time to be processed so players without a TUE participate at their own risk.

If players need medical attention during the event, please ensure that they check with the doctor treating them that any medications they receive are not prohibited

## CONCUSSION TESTING

The IFF has published Concussion Guidelines and a Concussion Recognition Tools.

Concussion is a type of brain injury that occurs from a knock to the head or body. Recognising concussion is critical to ensure appropriate management and prevention of further injury.

The Concussion Recognition Tool quick field test is recommended to help decide the status (return to play or further evaluation by medical professional utilising SCAT 5 Concussion Recognition Tool)

Copies of the quick field test checklist will be available at the match secretariat. Please ensure your team medical staff are informed of this.

# LOCAL ORGANISATION

## TRANSPORTS

Arrival & departure transport schedules to/from airports has been fixed and agreed with teams. Transportation to/from Palasport Latisana has been fixed. Departure point from Bella Italia Village is Le Vele hotel.

## LOCKER ROOMS

Locker rooms will change during the tournament. The locker room plan is available on the noticeboard at the athlete's entrance.

Access to the locker room is allowed from 90 minutes before the beginning of the match. Teams must leave the locker room no more than 45 minutes after the end of the match.

## FIRST AID

First aid providers, driver and ambulance available in each venue.

## HOSPITAL "BEATA VERGINE DELLE GRAZIE"

Via Sabbionera 45, Latisana - 17 km from Bella Italia Village

## EXTRA ACTIVITIES

Bella Italia EFA Village offers extra activities at no extra cost, e.g.:

Fitness centre

Indoor and outdoor swimming pools

Outdoor walks within Bella Italia or to the beach

Electronic keys that open the gate to access the beach will be available at the reception by leaving a deposit of 10 Euro.



# REFEREE INSTRUCTIONS

## FLUENCY AND FLOATING OF THE GAME

Avoid long breaks or interruptions  
Strict against any incorrect waste of time  
Use advantage according to promote a floating game

## COMMUNICATION

In the game = needed amount but not breaking the game fluency  
During intermissions = only in the corridors, not on the field of play  
After the game = willingness to discuss & develop the sport together with the teams

## STRICT TOWARDS

Physical / verbal abuse – from anyone towards anyone  
Tackles / physical offences to head, knees or when a player has no possibility/intention to play the ball in accordance with the IFF physical play guidelines  
All offences “after the situation” or “off-the-ball”  
Misconduct of all kinds

## MATCH PENALTIES

Match penalty if a player leaves the substitution zone and participates in an altercation  
All match penalties except Technical match penalty -> 1 game automatic suspension

## LEAVING THE SUBSTITUTION ZONE TO ENGAGE IN AN ALTERCATION

The goal -> Players should stay in the substitution zone when there is an altercation.  
Engaging -> Physically or verbally with an opponent or approaches the referees  
No additional offence has to be committed – The bar is set very low  
Match penalty -> 1 game automatic suspension.

**Please work together with us to keep  
your players in the substitution zone.**

## MATCH PENALTIES

The IFF expects players & team officials to show respect to the referees at all times. No shouting at the referees during or after the game. If something needs to be discussed with the referees (and the referees feel it is appropriate) then it can be done during the intermissions or after the game, and away from the rink.

Any abuse of the referees will be harshly dealt with by the Event Disciplinary Function.

## REFEREE COACH

Referee coaches are in the arena after each game.  
The list of daily referee nominations is available from the match secretariat each morning.

# INFORMATION ABOUT THE MATCH SECRETARIAT, TEAM LISTS & LINE-UPS

## BEFORE THE MATCH

**OFFICIAL TEAM LIST** - includes all players (20) and officials (10) from your team list. Only 5 officials may participate to the match – please remember to cross off those not in the match

**TEAM LINE-UP FORM** - every player on the team list must be included to the line-up form. Your first line as shown on the form will be the line-up that is announced by the match speaker before the start of the game

Team list & line-up form must be handed in to the match secretariat **NO LATER THAN 60 MINS** before the start of the match

Official team lists and the team line up forms will be available tomorrow at the match secretariat before your first match.

## AFTER THE MATCH

At the end of the match, the team manager must go to the match secretariat table. The match record will be printed and signed by the referees and then the team managers

Teams can receive a copy of the match record at the match secretariat upon request.

## CHANGING THE PLAYER

Requests for changes to the list must be made in writing to the IFF ([competition@floorball.sport](mailto:competition@floorball.sport)). Requests should state why a player needs to be changed, which player is being removed and which player (from the emergency list) shall be added to the team. Instructions on accreditation pick-up and new team lists will be given once the change is confirmed

## SHIRT NUMBERS

Shirt numbers should remain the same for each player during the event, but if for some reason you need to change a number this must be advised to either the IFF or match secretariat at least 60mins prior to a match. The earlier the better
